COVID-19 Frequently Asked Questions

Please note that this situation is fluid. We will update this document as information becomes available. Additionally, weekly communication will be sent from schools and teachers.

Closures

All Louisiana public schools have been mandated to close until April 13, 2020. All CCSS schools are following this mandate. Field trips, athletic events and practices, and all other extra-curricular activities have been suspended until April 13, 2020.

District Facilities

Beginning Tuesday, March 17, 2020, access to the CCSS facilities will be limited to only those with pre-approval.

School Calendar

CCSS administration is evaluating the situation, reviewing the Governor's proclamation, and working with BESE to make the best decisions for our district. We are waiting on further guidance from the Louisiana Department of Education on the potential impacts to our school calendar. We will continue to provide updates through JCampus phone calls, as well as the district app, website, and social media channels.

Spring Break will not change

We will still plan for the original spring break dates (April 10-17, 2020). Students will return on April 20, 2020.

Medication

Medications will be available for pickup from each school site from 7-10 am on Tuesday, March 17, 2020. Please email questions@centralcss.org if you need further information.

Meals

We will begin meal pickup on Monday, March 23, 2020. More details will be announced soon. If you need meals prior to this date, please view [this list of other nearby pickup locations](#).

Learning

Pre-K through 5th grade students received a paper packet for multiple weeks of review material. Students in grades 6 through 12 were instructed to log into online systems for review work. This week (March 16-20, 2020), students should continue these activities.

We are working with the Louisiana Department of Education and vendors for solutions to distance learning. We plan to announce plans for next week (beginning March 23, 2020) and beyond in the near future.

Testing

Statewide ACT dates are postponed from the original March 17, 2020 date. The Louisiana Department of Education is working with ACT to schedule a new test date after students have returned to school. Other high school assessments are still scheduled for the original dates. LEAP 2025 assessments for grades 3-8 have been postponed until April 27, 2020 at the earliest. We will release more information on this soon.

Ring Ceremony

The Central High School ring ceremony will be postponed from the original March 22, 2020 date. We will announce a new date in the future.

Prom

We will still plan for the original prom date of April 25, 2020. If the location or date for prom must change, we will announce those changes as information becomes available.

Graduation

Graduation is still scheduled for May 19, 2020. If the location or date for graduation must change, we will announce those changes as information becomes available. We will be working with the Louisiana Department of Education to ensure this disruption does not impact the graduation of our seniors.

Dual Enrollment

According to the Board of Regents, dual enrollment courses must continue virtually until further notice. Facilitators at the school will be contacting students with instructions.
